



## The Detail

**Quiz Trails** – Both Stratford-upon-Avon and Warwick offer a mix of historical, observational and fun questions to answer during a 90' walk. Some clues to the answers are more obvious than others so keep your eyes peeled and look high and low! A 60' trail is available for those preferring a shorter walk and it is more suitable if the children are aged under nine.

There is the option to theme the trails for private party booking for which there will be a charge of £25.00 per hour to make the changes to the quiz sheet.

**Meeting Point** – We usually meet at the Globe gastro pub in Warwick and the Falcon hotel in Stratford-upon-Avon, but if they are busy, or an alternative venue is preferred, then another venue will be booked to meet up with your Trivia Trail host who will give a short introduction regarding the trail, advising on any points that need to be taken into consideration such as steps, toilets etc. Teams return to the same venue at the end of the trail for scoring with the option to purchase a well-earned drink!

**Smoking** – By law all venues have a policy of no smoking.

**Food & Drink** - Drinks and food can usually be ordered at the meeting-up venues to be paid for direct to the venue before leaving. We are happy to help with pre-booking a light bite or meal at extra cost. Please contact us to chat through in more detail and we can give you a quote for a quiz trail and meal package.

**Arrival & Finishing Time** - So as not to keep other teams waiting please turn up on time. Quiz trails will start 10-15 minutes after the meeting up time. If unable to join in or delayed please text your host to advise. Teams set off at three to four minute staggered intervals so if running a few minutes late there is still time to join in. If a team booked onto a scheduled trail has still not returned two hours after their start time the host has the right to start scoring the quiz sheets so that the other teams are not kept waiting.

**Teams** – Of two or more, up to six for larger groups. Solo quizzers can go round on their own, or there may be the option to join a team – please ask at the time of booking.

**Large Private Groups** – Maximum number for a private party booking is 60. Maximum number of teams is ideally 10 to keep staggered team set-off times to a minimum so that no one is kept hanging around for too long before setting off and at the end for checking scores. Can be booked for a date and time to suit seven days a week, daytime or evening.

**Small Private Groups** - There is no minimum number for a private group trail, just a minimum spend of £50.00. Ideal for birthdays, hen do's, visitors, team-building or just wanting an enjoyable walk whilst getting to know so much more about these pretty, historic market towns. Can be booked for a date and time to suit seven days a week, daytime or evening.



**Disabilities/Pushchairs** - There are a few gentle gradients on the trails which are manageable for pushchairs. We would recommend assistance for manual wheelchair users. There are options of alternative routes on the quiz trail to avoid steep steps whilst still giving access to all the clues. These are highlighted on the quiz sheets.

Please always advise at the time of booking of any wheelchair/pushchair users to ensure detours are included in the quiz sheet directions.

**Attire** - The trail involves walking outdoors and as there are some gentle gradients, flat, comfortable shoes/boots are recommended. And don't forget to bring an umbrella and waterproof if rain forecast, and suntan lotion and sunglasses for sunny days.

**Toilets** – There is access to a few public toilets during the trails which are highlighted on the quiz sheets.

**Children** – Ideal for children aged 9-16 who can join in looking for the answers with adult assistance in the 90' trails. We recommend the 60' trails if there are children aged 8 and under in your party. Children aged 8 are free of charge and push chairs welcome. Detours are included in the trails to avoid steep steps. All children aged 18 and under must be accompanied by an adult (over 21) and are the sole responsibility of that adult. Groups of school children must be accompanied by the appropriate number of school staff and/or parents.

**Safety** - All participants are responsible for their own safety. Please use pedestrian walkways and footpaths at all times. Cross the roads using zebra crossings and at traffic lights wherever possible, checking there is no oncoming traffic before stepping onto the road. We cannot be held responsible for accident or injury to life or limb incurred whilst on a Trivia Trail. Nor can we be held responsible for the loss or damage to personal belongings or vehicles.

**Internet** –The quiz trails are fun and sociable and offer a great opportunity to look around and enjoy the scenery whilst chatting and interacting with your team mates to answer the questions, so the use of ipads, mobile phones or other internet devices are excluded!

**Dogs - Warwick:** Dogs are welcome on the Warwick trail as long as one of the team members is able to enter the couple of venues whilst the dog/s are kept outside to find the answers to these questions. The trail also includes one short detour as dogs are not allowed through Warwick Castle courtyard. Dogs must be accompanied by their owner with a maximum of one dog per adult and on a lead at all times. Please advise at the time of booking if there are dogs being brought along to ensure they are accepted in the meeting-up venue.

**Dogs - Stratford-upon-Avon:** Sorry, this trail is not suitable to include dogs as it includes walking along very busy tourist areas.

**Getting Here - Warwick:** By road Warwick is about a two mile drive from Junction 15 of the M40, and Warwick Station a 10 minute walk from the town centre. Warwick Parkway station is



a five minute taxi ride from the town centre/30 minute walk. Birmingham international airport is a 25 minute taxi ride away.

**Getting Here - Stratford-upon-Avon:** is a few minutes' drive from Junction 15 and 16 of the M40, and Stratford Station a 10 minute walk from the town centre.

**Parking** - There is pay and display parking on the roads in both towns but time slots are usually limited from 30 minutes – 2 hours so best to head for one of the pay and display car parks listed below.

**Disabled Parking** - No charge for drivers displaying a Disabled Badge in all town centre council car parks. No time limit on single yellow line parking provided clock and the disabled sticker are displayed, and that an obstruction is not caused.

### Warwick Car Parks

**Linen Street, CV34 4DT**, just off Bowling Green Street. 3 storey. Pay & Display. £6 for 6 hours or more. Height restriction 1.9m. Open: 8am to 8pm. Closes 8pm – 7am daily. Two minute walk to town centre and three minutes from The Globe gastro pub.

**Cape Road, CV34 4UN**. Outdoors. Spaces on right as you drive in. It is available and free of charge after 5.30pm every evening and for 24 hours Saturday, Sunday and bank holidays. (Ignore signs saying private parking as council staff only use it Mon-Fri 8am - 5pm). Five minute walk to town centre.

**Council Car Park, Barrack Street, CV34 4TH**, entrance 25 yards on, on left, into top of three storey car park. One minute walk to the Globe gastro pub if meeting-up there. It is FREE after 5.30pm every evening, pay & display on Saturdays till 6pm and then FREE; FREE Sundays and FREE bank holidays. (Ignore signs saying private parking as council staff only use it Mon-Fri 8am - 5pm). Only suitable for large cars on ground or top floor as narrow turning points when going up and down floors. Entrance to ground floor on Theatre Street. Height restriction 1.87m. 10 disabled bays. Two minute walk to town centre.

**The Butts, CV34 4ST**. Outdoors. Council Pay & Display. £4 for 24 hours. 6pm – 8am 50p. One disabled bay. 20 spaces. 5 minute walk to town centre.

### Stratford-upon-Avon Car Parks

**Church Street, CV37 6HB**. On edge of Old Town. Drive down side of Windmill pub. Two minute walk to Falcon Hotel on Church Street. Outdoor Council car park available to the public only **from 1600** Mon – Fri, all day Sat, Sun and bank holidays. £1.00 per hour up to 4 hours, £6.00 for up to 9 hours. (1600-0800: £2.00).

**Chapel Lane, CV37 6BE** in Kes Grammar School. NB: only available day time in school holidays as belongs to the school, otherwise evenings and weekends up till midnight. Two minute walk



to RSC and Falcon Hotel. Outdoor (Council). £1.00 x 1 hour, £2.30 x 2 hours, £3/£5.00 for 3 to 5 hours, £8.00 for 7am – 5pm (have to leave by 5pm), £3.00 5pm – midnight.

**Windsor Street, CV37 6NL**, at side of Coach Terminal. Seven minute walk to Falcon Hotel, Church Street. Four storey Council car park available to the public 24 hours. £1.00 per hour up to 4 hours, then £6.00 for 9 hours, and £2.00 overnight from 1600 to 0800.

**Cancellation Policy** – Payments are non-refundable due to no-shows, late arrival for the confirmed start time, or cancellations less than 30 days prior to the booking date.

Cancellations more than 30 days but less than 60 days prior to the booking date will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations more than 60 days prior to the booking date will receive a 90% (or less to cover payment charges) refund. If Trivia Trails cancels the booking at any time the booker will receive 100% refund.

If the event is cancelled with mutual agreement by Trivia Trails and the booker due to adverse weather conditions the booker will receive a full refund less any costs incurred, or if preferred a credit note to reschedule for another day.
