### Quiz Trail Stratford-upon-Avon – The Detail

**Quiz Trail** – The quiz sheet contains a mix of historical, observational and fun questions. Some clues to the answers are more obvious than others so keep your eyes peeled and look high and low!

**Teams** – Of two, four, or up to six for larger groups. Solo quizzers can go round on their own, or there may be the option to join a team – please ask at the time of booking.

**Disabilities/Pushchairs** - There are a few gentle gradients on the trail which are manageable for pushchairs. We would recommend assistance for manual wheelchair users. There are options of alternative routes on the quiz trail to avoid steps whilst still giving access to all the clues. These are highlighted on the quiz sheet.

**Meeting Point** – Your host gives a short introduction regarding the trail, advising on any points that need to be taken into consideration such as steps, toilets etc. Teams usually return to the same venue at the end of the trail for scoring with the option to purchase a well-earned drink!

**Smoking** – By law all venues have a policy of no smoking.

**Food & Drink** - All extra drinks and food can be ordered and paid for directly to the venue. We are happy to help with pre-booking a light bite or meal. Please contact us to chat through in more detail and we can put forward some suggestions.

**Arrival & Finishing Time** - So as not to keep other teams waiting please turn up on time. Quiz trails will start approximately 15 minutes after the meeting up time. If unable to join in or delayed please text your host to advise. If short of time the included drink can be ordered after the trail has been completed. Teams set off at two to three minute staggered intervals so if running a few minutes late there is still time to join in. If a team returns more than two hours after their start time without advising the host, the host has the right to start scoring the quiz sheets and exclude that team from the prize giving.

**Large Private Groups** – Maximum number is ideally 50 to 60 although parties as large as 90 have also been booked so please ask and an appropriate meeting venue can be put forward to cater for large numbers. Ideally maximum number of teams is 10 to keep staggered team set-off times to a minimum so that no one is kept hanging around for too long before setting off and at the end for checking scores.

**Small Private Groups** – The minimum value of bookings is £50.00 for a quiz trail to go ahead. Ideal for birthdays, hen do's, visitors, team-building or just wanting an enjoyable walk whilst getting to know so much more about the history of Stratford-upon-Avon's town centre . Available seven days a week.

**Attire** - The trail involves 90 minutes of walking outdoors and as there are some gentle gradients, flat, comfortable shoes/boots are recommended. And don't forget to bring an umbrella and waterproof if rain forecast, and suntan lotion and sunglasses for sunny days.

**Toilets** - Free public toilet locations are highlighted on the quiz trail sheet.

**Children** – Ideal for children aged 7-16 who can join in looking for the answers with adult assistance in the 90' trail. We recommend the 60' trail for children aged 9 and under. Children aged 8 and under welcome to come along free of charge and push chairs welcome. All children aged 18 and under must be accompanied by an adult (over 21) and are the sole responsibility of that adult. Groups of school children must be accompanied by the appropriate number of school staff and/or parents.

**Safety** - All participants are responsible for their own safety. Please use pedestrian walkways at all times. Cross the roads using zebra crossings and at traffic lights wherever possible, checking there is no oncoming traffic before stepping onto the road. We cannot be held responsible for accident or injury to life or limb incurred whilst on this or any other Trivia Trail. Nor can we be held responsible for the loss or damage to personal belongings or vehicles.

**Internet** –This is a **fun** team quiz so please work together as a team to find the answers to all the clues which can be found on the trail!! Any team reported to the host as being seen using ipads, mobile phones or other internet devices to source the answers will have 10 points deducted from their final score!

**Dogs** - Are allowed subject to the meeting venue's approval. The Mercure Shakespeare hotel where we usually meet is fine with dogs as long as they are kept on a lead and are quiet. Dogs are not permitted in the four venues visited during the trail but other team members can look for the answers to these questions whilst the dog owner waits outside for a few minutes.

**Getting Here** - By road Stratford-upon-Avon is a few minutes' drive from Junction 15 and 16 of the M40, and Stratford Station a 10 minute walk from the town centre.

**Parking** - There is pay and display parking on the roads but time slots are usually limited from 30 minutes – 2 hours so best to head for one of the pay & display car parks:

**Church Street, CV37 6HB.** On edge of Old Town. Drive down side of Windmill pub. Four minute walk to the Mercure Shakespeare Hotel. Outdoor Council car park available to the public Mon – Fri from 1600, all day Sat, Sun and bank holidays. £1.00 per hour up to 4 hours, £6.00 for up to 9 hours. (1600-0800: £2.00).

**Chapel Lane, CV37 6BE** in KES Grammar School. NB: only available day time in school holidays. Two minute walk to RSC and Falcon Hotel. Outdoor (Council) car park available to the public

all day up till midnight. £1.00 x 1 hour, £2.30 x 2 hours, £3/£5.00 for 3 to 5 hours, £8.00 for 7am – 5pm (have to leave by 5pm), £3.00 5pm – midnight.

**Windsor Street, CV37 6NL**, at side of Coach Terminal. Five to seven minute walk to Falcon Hotel, Church Street. Four storey Council car park available to the public 24 hours. £1.00 per hour up to 4 hours, then £6.00 for 9 hours, and £2.00 overnight from 1600 to 0800.

**Disabled Parking** - No charge for drivers displaying a Disabled Badge in Stratford town centre council car parks.

**Accommodation** - There are plenty of hotels and B&B's to choose from located in the town centre and surrounding villages. Visit [www.visitstratforduponavon.co.uk](http://www.visitstratforduponavon.co.uk) for details.

**Cancellation Policy** – Payments are non-refundable due to no-shows, late arrival for the confirmed start time, or cancellations less than 30 days prior to the booking date. Cancellations more than 30 days but less than 60 days prior to the booking date will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations more than 60 days prior to the booking date will receive a 90% (or less to cover payment charges) refund. If Trivia Trails cancels the booking at any time the booker will receive 100% refund.

If the event is cancelled with mutual agreement by Trivia Trails and the booker due to adverse weather conditions the booker will receive a full refund less any costs incurred, or if preferred a credit note to reschedule for another day.
